

## Fourth Annual Snapshot Report Key insights



## **Emissions reduction**

### • 57 signatories reduced emissions through:

- ✓ less land & air travel
- ✓ reduced fleet size, fuel use & more EVs
- ✓ improved energy efficiency
- ✓ use of renewable electricity
- 8% Scope 1 & 2 emissions reduction for signatories reporting in two consecutive years
- 11% reduction for 58 signatories who have reported in all 4 years



## **Emissions targets**

- **63%** have a 1.5 degree target
- **22%** have a verified SBTi
- **60%** are following SBTi guidance
- **95%** are considering targets in planning cycles



# Supporting suppliers

- **98%** are supporting suppliers to reduce emissions by:
  - ✓ Reducing emissions across value chain through waste reduction, electrifying fleets, procuring renewable energy & improving energy efficiency
  - ✓ Driving emissions reporting in supply chain through setting criteria in procurement policies & contracts & offering general emissions reporting support to suppliers



# **Supporting employees**



- **99%** are supporting employees to reduce emissions
- Popular initiatives include:
  - ✓ flexible working
  - ✓ the provision of facilities to encourage active transport & low-carbon commuting



## Adaptation

- 51% assessed and disclosed climate change risks
  Further 26% are working on it
- **TCFD** is the preferred approach

## Areas focusing on next to reduce emissions:

#### **Barriers:**

- supply chain emissions
- o EVs
- improving energy efficiency

- dependence on suppliers

- rate of technological development/innovation
- lack of resources



## Investment

 Almost all reaffirmed or increased commitment to \$9.5 billion of investment over 5-year horizon to reduce their emissions
